COMPLETION OF STUDIES AND GRADUATION POLICY: POSTGRADUATE

- 1. Postgraduate students are not required to apply for graduation. Students eligible for graduation are reported to Registry Services by the relevant Programme Director or Convenor.
- 2. Postgraduates who embark on their studies in September have their results considered at a School Exam Board in November and ratified at the University Exam Board shortly afterwards. Students who have completed Richmond graduation requirements are awarded a diploma dated December of the same year.
- 3. Postgraduates who embark on their studies in January have their results considered at a School Exam Board in May and ratified at the University Exam Board in June. Students who have completed Richmond graduation requirements are awarded a diploma dated May of the same year.

Graduation Honours

- 4. Postgraduates achieving a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.666 will be awarded the degree with Distinction.
- 5. Postgraduates achieving a cumulative GPA within the range of 3.333 to 3.665 will be awarded the degree with Merit.
- 6. Postgraduates achieving a cumulative GPA within the range of 3.0 to 3.332 will be awarded a Pass degree.
