

GRADING POLICY, POSTGRADUATE

1. Overall final grades for courses are assigned by instructors at the end of every semester or summer session. All grades are subject to confirmation at the Formal School Exam Boards and University Exam Board.
2. Each letter grade is assigned a numerical equivalent on the following scale for **postgraduate** study:

A	4.000	Excellent
A-	3.666	Very Good
B+	3.333	Above satisfactory
B	3.000	Satisfactory (<i>also cumulative GPA required for award of the degree</i>)
B-	2.666	Redeemable fail
C+	2.333	Fail – Poor (<i>may be awarded at graded activity level, but not at course level</i>)
C	2.000	Fail – Deficient (<i>may be awarded at graded activity level, but not at course level</i>)
C-	1.666	Fail – Seriously Deficient (<i>may be awarded at graded activity level, but not at course level</i>)
F	0.000	Fail (<i>may be awarded at graded activity level, and is awarded at course level for any course grade calculated to be lower than B-</i>)
FA	0.000	Fail (Attendance)
FS	0.000	Fail (Non-Submission)
FX	0.000	Fail (Academic Misconduct)
