

## GRADING POLICY, POSTGRADUATE

---

1. Overall final grades for courses are assigned by instructors at the end of every semester or summer session. All grades are subject to confirmation at the Formal School Exam Boards and University Exam Board.
2. Each letter grade is assigned a numerical equivalent on the following scale for **postgraduate** study:

POSTGRADUATE GRADING SCALE		
Grade	Grade Point	Descriptor
A	4.0	Excellent
A-	3.7	Very Good
B+	3.3	Above satisfactory
B	3.0	Satisfactory ( <i>also cumulative GPA required for award of the degree</i> )
B-	2.7	Redeemable fail
C+	2.3	Fail – Poor ( <i>may be awarded at graded activity level, but not at course level</i> )
C	2.0	Fail – Deficient ( <i>may be awarded at graded activity level, but not at course level</i> )
C-	1.7	Fail – Seriously Deficient ( <i>may be awarded at graded activity level, but not at course level</i> )
F	0.0	Fail ( <i>may be awarded at graded activity level, and is awarded at course level for any course grade calculated to be lower than B-</i> )
FA	0.0	Fail (Attendance)

Additional grades that do not have a numerical equivalent and are not used in GPA calculations are:

AU	Audit
I	Incomplete
P	Pass (non-credit only)
TR	Transfer Credit
TRP	Transfer Credit (provisional)
W	Withdrawn
